Volunteer Programme: New wildlife warden, Dean Jones arrived & will be starting wildlife walks

in May.

Volunteers are starting to arrive. Please let Tasha know if you can think of any tasks which

volunteers could help with.

Forestry Project: LTFP won't be accepted until changes have been made to maps & thinning & felling plans. IL currently updating the maps on GIS system & producing any additional maps

which are required.

Gary Servant has indicated that it would take 4/5 days to complete additional material but due

to other commitments, won't be able to complete till June.

Brief sent to Making Local Woodlands Work (MLWW).

We have received 2 enquiries regarding purchase of fallen elm. IL to photograph & provide

measurements of length & girth.

Green Grants: Final costs still to be supplied on just 1 remaining solar installation.

Small grant agreed towards Permaculture course to be held at Earth Connections Centre.

The grant will cover £100 towards cost of tutor plus £300 (ie 50% towards 6 subsidised places)

Fencing: All new gates now completed.

Green Shed: Repairs to green shed door ongoing.

All weather lighting ongoing.

Eigg Electric: Still waiting for Afnor "High Voltage Systems Safe Working" course to become

available.

All 4 wind turbines now working again.

Tracks: Thanks to visiting contractor who filled in the worst of the potholes on track up to hall.

CC & TM still to walk the tracks & note drains & culverts which need attention.

Trust Properties: All leases now up to date & signed.

List of maintenance required for each property provided.

House Sites: Slight changes to road map suggested. Updated version to be circulated. Some discussion about whether or not it may be possible to include a clause which would prevent houses being sold as holiday cottages in the future.

Housing for Rent: Ongoing

Old Surgery: Meeting held with Gill McVicar on 12th April. The first stage would be for the building to be declared surplus to requirements. A survey of the building has been carried out but as yet no decisions have been made as to what might be included (ie sheds & garden).

Eigg Trading: Maintenance to An Laimhrig ie waiting room painted & guttering fixed still to be done.

Meeting held earlier with Andy Tuckwood & lan Cameron re new waste contract.

Notice for expressions of interest to be circulated & printed out & displayed on notice boards.

Full details will be sent out on receipt of applications ~ closing date 27th May.

The contract will commence 1st September. There will be significant changes to the waste collection which will be made clear to residents nearer the time.

Business charges will not be enforced in the current financial year.

Wigwams: Foundation pads currently in progress.

Delivery date to be confirmed next week but expected to be early May.

Cable for electric connection ordered & expected to arrive shortly.

Eigg Adventures supplied a tender for management of the pods which has been accepted.

GIS System: Desktop computer purchased & GIS installed. We also now have a colour printer/scanner copier which can print A3 & a black laser printer.

Once bank statements received, a claim can be submitted in full for all equipment & business manager wages.

Pier Wifi hotspot: Currently identifying spec for equipment required. This includes an aerial which will cover a 500m radius, new router & software.

Other connections in the vicinity will in future be password protected.

It is thought that results of questionnaire will provide valuable information on visitor's experience.
